**Mmbangiseni Terrance Magoro**

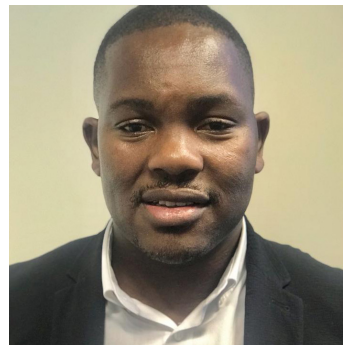
